Project Description

LADWP is working hard to make important electric infrastructure improvements in the **Bel Air, Beverly Crest, Westwood, and Holmby Hills** communities. These areas have experienced significant reliability issues due to increasing power demand. The circuits servicing these communities are operating **120% of capacity**.

This project will:

- Upgrade electric infrastructure that was installed in the 1930s
- Improve reliability
- Increase capacity
- Install four new underground circuits (approximately 27,000 feet of new cable)

Construction on Sunset Blvd will begin June 25, 2019 and continue through Summer 2020.

Construction on nearby streets is expected to begin in 2020 and will include Bellagio Rd, Chalon Rd, Bel Air Rd, and S. Beverly Glen Blvd. More details about this second phase will be provided at a later date.

Sunset Blvd Construction:

Construction will involve excavating and trenching to install new conduit and cable. Crews will be working **simultaneously** at the following locations:

- **Sunset Blvd between the 405 freeway and Bellagio Rd.**
- **Sunset Blvd between S. Beverly Glen Blvd and Carolwood Dr.**

Traffic and Public Safety Measures:

- At least one lane will remain open in each direction to maintain both eastbound and westbound traffic flow.
- At the end of each work day, all lanes will be restored to traffic.
- Traffic Control Officers and flaggers will be on-site to manage traffic flow.
- 10 changeable message signs will be placed throughout the work zone and adjacent areas to inform motorists.
- Public safety mitigation plan in partnership with LAFD and LAPD will be in effect.
- Security personnel will be deployed for additional support.


