## WHAT IS FIRST LAST MILE PLANNING?

An individual's trip is understood as the entire journey from origin to destination. Individuals may use a number of modes of transport to complete the journey - they may walk, drive, ride a bicycle, take a train, or - in many cases - combine a number of modes. Bus and rail services often form the core of a trip, but users complete the first and last portion on their own. For example, they must first walk, bike, drive or roll themselves to and from the nearest station.

This is referred to as the first and last mile of the user's trip, or "first/last mile" (FLM) for short.

As part of the **Purple Line (Line D)** Extension Section 3, Metro is constructing the Westwood/UCLA rail station. It is also working in coordination with local cities and communities to help improve this "first last mile" experience.

You will notice that plans are high-level, conceptual designs. This is because there will be additional studies and analysis related to traffic, safety, feasibility, and impacts on the environment.




## ENTER YOUR COMMENTS BY MARCH 6, 2020
